Vice Chairwoman Page presented the following Resolution and moved it adoption:

**A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING PARKING MOTOR VEHICLES
AND TRAILERS ON TOWNSHIP ROADS IN THE
UNINCORPORATED AREA OF PERRY TOWNSHIP**

WHEREAS, The Ohio Revised Code, Section 505.17 (A), has granted townships the authority to adopt regulations and orders as are necessary to address motor vehicle parking in the unincorporated areas of a township. This authorization includes, among other powers, the power to regulate parking on established roadways proximate to buildings on private property as necessary to provide access to property by public safety vehicles and equipment, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Perry Township Trustees, Lake County, Ohio desires to exercise its authority to regulate parking on roads within the unincorporated areas of Perry Township pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 505.17(A); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Perry Township Trustees has determined that the public safety and welfare would be best served by regulations prohibiting parking on roads within the unincorporated area of Perry Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Perry Township Trustees hereby permit the parking of motor vehicles on all residential roads that are owned and maintained by the Township, subject to the following limitations:

- 1) Parking is prohibited on the fire hydrant side of any road.
- 2) Parking is prohibited against the flow of traffic.
- 3) Parking is prohibited on all Perry Township maintained roads when snowfall accumulation exceed two (2) inches in depth.
- 4) Violation of this resolution constitutes a minor misdemeanor carrying such penalties as provided therefore by the Ohio Revised Code. Fines levied and collected under Ohio Revised Code Section 505.17 (A) shall be paid into the township general revenue fund.
